




How will I get to the Orthoptic Clinic?




Waiting Area






You can use portable games or tablets.


Waiting Area

Orthoptist




An Orthoptist will call your name

Eye Tests


We will check your vision

Nurse


You might see a Nurse



Eye Drops


You may need eye drops





This is so we can look inside your eye


Optometrist




Next you may see an Optometrist
