



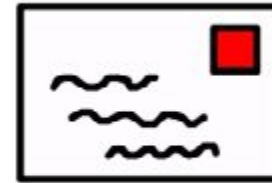

You will sit in the waiting area

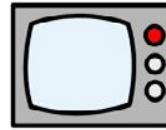
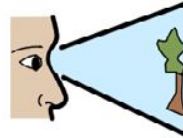


You can listen to the radio

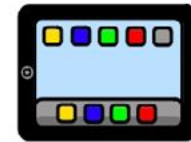

You can use portable games or tablets.

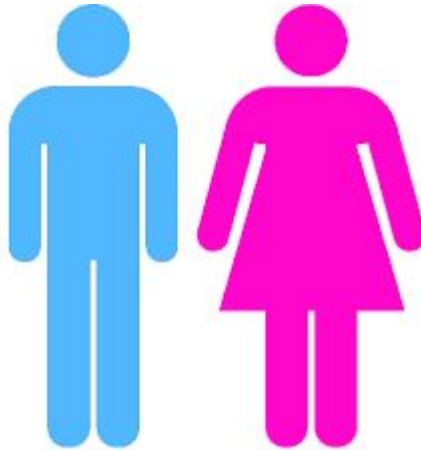
Waiting Area

Orthoptist

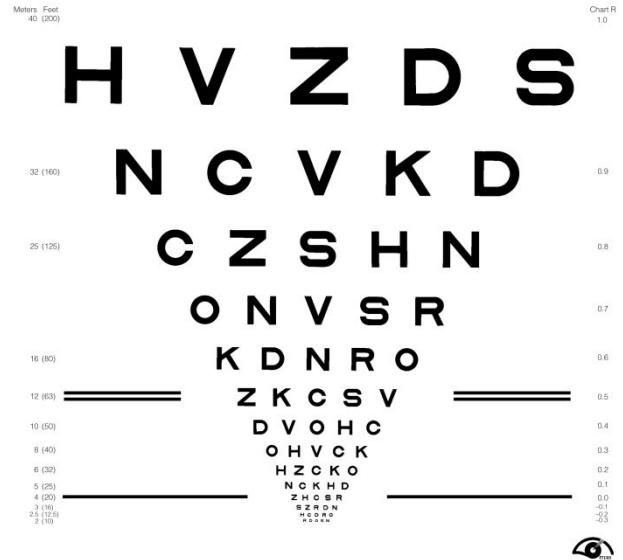
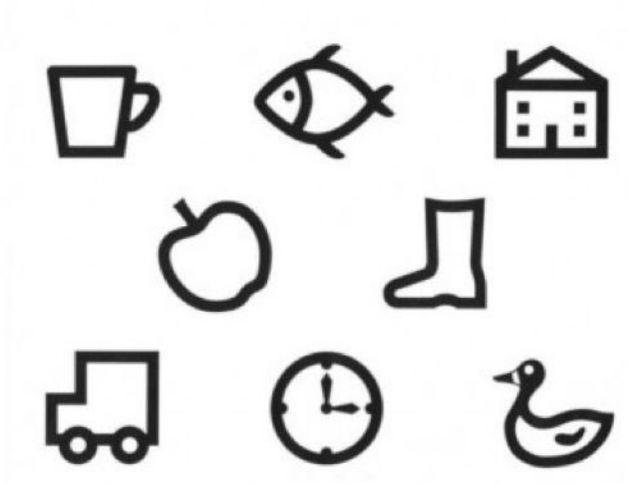


An Orthoptist will call your name

You may see a Male or Female Orthoptist

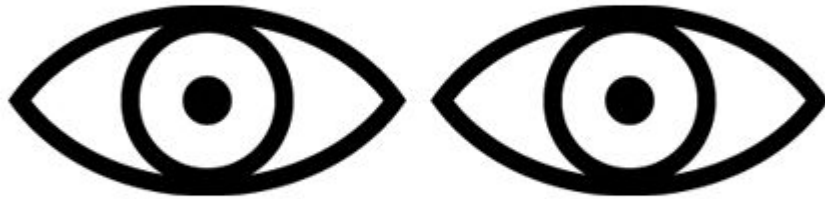
Eye Tests

We will check how well your eyes work together with different equipment



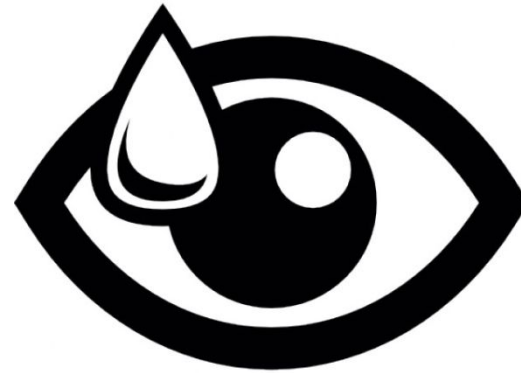
Nurse

You might see a Nurse



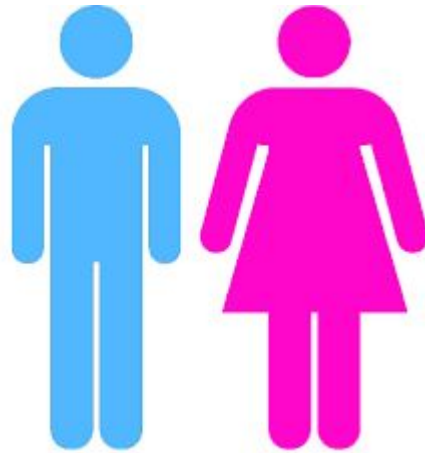
Eye Drops

This is so we can look inside your eye

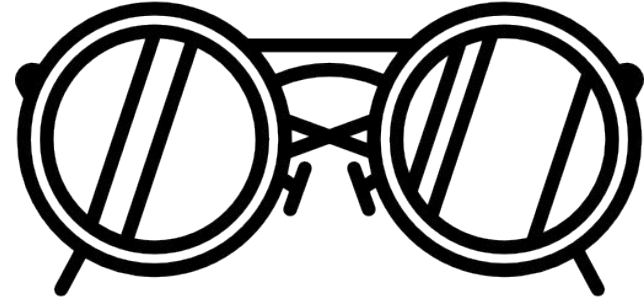
Optometrist
